Description			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
<p>The artists' residency in Poland lasted from May 20th to May 26th, 2024. During this time, Artists were accommodated in the picturesque Palace Zegrzyński, located by Lake Zegrzyńskie, where until May 25th, a painting workshop with invited artists from Poland, Czech Republic, Lithuania and Latvia was held outdoors every day. During this period, the artists painted acrylic and oil paintings on canvases expressing their views on equality. On Friday, May 24th, an outdoor painting workshop for artists and the local community was organized at Barbarka Hill in the heart of Serock, on the site of the former settlement. During the workshop, we discussed equality and art together. Thirty people from Serock participated in the event. On May 25th, a vernissage took place, where the artworks created were presented. After the vernissage, the artists and guests participated in a special performance titled "21 Elements" by the Smile Theatre - Łódź theatre for people with disabilities. The performance addressed the theme of otherness and being different, and perfectly complemented the themes of our art workshops. After the vernissage and the performance, the artists and local government representatives attended a ceremonial dinner, which marked the culmination of the week-long workshops. The Mayor of Serock Town and Municipality, the Chairman of the City Council, and the event coordinators participated in the ceremony.</p> <p>It was difficult to maintain gender balance as more women wanted to participate in events. The total number of artists participating in the Creative Residency is 8, 31 people took part in the public painting workshops on May 24, and we hosted over 35 people at the vernissage.
